Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) is the primary link between a troop's Scouts and its adult leaders. One of the major parts of the SPL's job is to appoint other troop leaders who are able and diligent, not just his friends or other popular Scouts. Their responsibilities are also to provide valuable leadership in planning and carrying out the troop's program of outdoor activities, service projects, and events. They will work with the Scoutmaster in training other youth leaders. They delegate tasks to the ASPL as needed, provide necessary follow-up, and ensure they are ready to assume your responsibilities as needed.

- Be on time for meetings and activities
- Run all troop meetings, events, activities, PLC meetings, annual program planning conference
- Appoint other troop youth leaders with the advice and counsel of the Scoutmaster
- Assign duties and responsibilities to youth leaders
- Assist the Scoutmaster with youth leadership training
- Lead ILST training with ASPL

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend a majority of troop meetings (3 out of 4 monthly) and Court of Honors (3 out of 4 annually)
- Attend all PLC quarterly meetings, PLC training sessions, and annual planning meeting
- Attend half of all troop campouts (6 out of 12 annually)
- Check and respond to troop emails/correspondence consistently
- Set a good example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law
- Show and help develop Scout spirit within the Troop
- Wear the Scout uniform correctly

PREFERRED SKILLS AND ITEMS:

- Attend NYLT training during the SPL term
- An email account that is included in the troop group email (for sending updates)
- Organization and planning skills
- Good communication skills
